WELCOME TO GOOD SHEPHERD

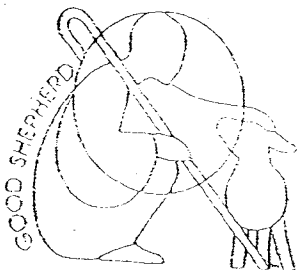
